## **SANTA BARBARA AIRPORT**

SBA is the closest option at only 5-10 minutes from UCSB and Isla Vista. MTD bus, taxis, car rental, and Lyft/Uber are all very active at the airport. SBA is extremely easy to fly in and out. Typically flights going out of SBA have layovers in LA, San Francisco, Seattle, Phoenix, Denver, Dallas or Atlanta. Airlines include Southwest, United, American Airlines, Alaska, and Delta.



## **LOS ANGELES INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT**

LAX is approximately 2 hours away from Santa Barbara and UCSB's campus. From LAX getting to UCSB is easy through the Santa Barbara Airbus, which picks up multiple times throughout the day. LAX offers a major airport hub with multiple direct flight options.



## **BURBANK AIRPORT**

Smaller than LAX, Burbank Airport is another great option with more direct flights than SBA. About 1.5 to 2 hours from UCSB's campus and is easily accessible through the Amtrak train from the airport to the Goleta station, which is about 3-5 minutes from campus.

Ramada Inn - About 4 miles from campus near Starbuck's and In n Out, call directly (805) 964-3511 and ask for the UCSB Alumni Rate with will give up to a 20% discount for members.

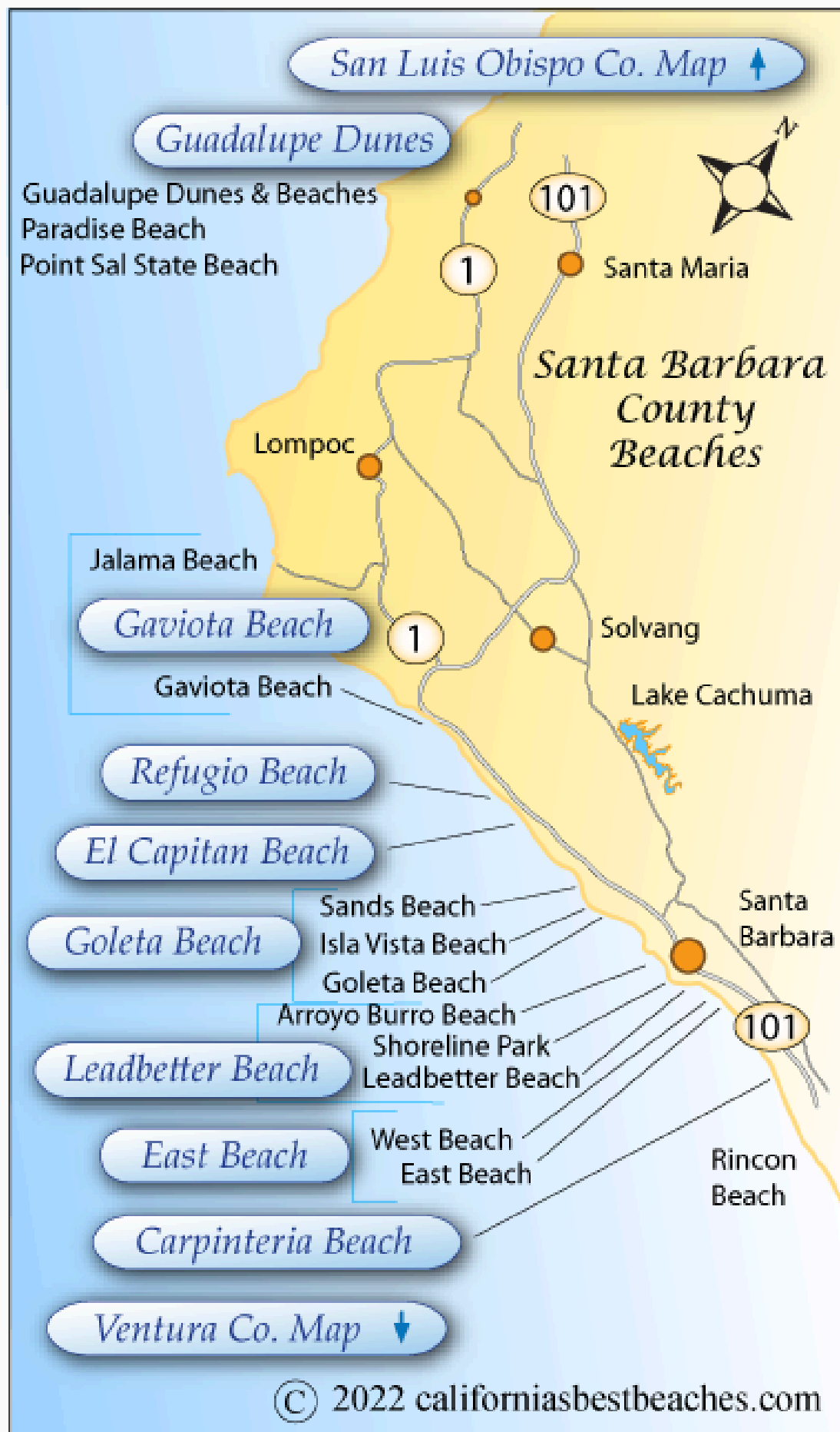
